

THE LATHKIL HALFGALLATHON

RULES:

- 1) In order to finish the race the entrant must complete four laps and consume four pints of the designated brew.
- 2) A lap is defined as one complete circuit of the road which encircles the Lathkil Hotel.
- 3) The grass adjacent to the chapel is out of bounds.
- 4) The laps may only be undertaken in a anticlockwise direction.
- 5) One pint of the designated brew is to be consumed prior to each lap.
- 6) All drinking must take place whilst the entrant is stationary at the drinking table.
- 7) The race will begin with a 'Le Mans' style start.
- 8) THERE WILL BE NO SPILLAGE.**
- 9) Spillage is defined as the wilful or excessive avoidance of swallowing whilst in the act of pouring, or the deliberate or accidental causing of a vessel, either full or partially so, to be unbalanced such that its contents are made external to said vessel and are thus rendered undrinkable.
- 10) Any entrant who contravenes any of the stated rules will be disqualified.
- 11) The steward's decision is final.
